

# All Saints Parish Hall Re-open Covid 19 Update



With the Government announcing that village halls and community buildings are able to start to open following the lockdown, the hall management has been working with the local authority and using the published guidance with regards to the safe re-opening of halls to ensure that they are Covid-19 secure.

Our aim is making sure the hall is kept as clean and safe as possible and that social distancing rules are adhered to. By working together with our users this will hopefully make the future working arrangements as effective as possible with the least amount of disruption to activities.

The hall has undergone a complete and thorough clean in order that we can start to re-open as from the 2<sup>nd</sup> September.

Great Yarmouth Environmental Health officers visited this week and inspected the premises and were completely satisfied with the actions we have taken and the procedures in place that are necessary for ensuring we keep a safe environment for all who use the building.

This includes the provision of hand sanitisers both outside and in all public areas of the building and appropriate signage. Face masks will be required to be worn.

The kitchen will be locked until further notice and all public areas such as the halls, corridors and toilets etc. are cleaned and disinfected on a daily basis.

In addition, all hirers have the responsibility to ensure that when they leave, that door handles and other touch points have been cleaned.

Initially a small number of groups will be starting to use the hall as we all get used to the working within the guidelines.

Following social distancing advice, it is necessary for the trustees to impose a limit on the number of people who may use the hall at any one time to ensure the 2 metre distancing rules can be adhered to.

**Anyone who may possibly be unwell and showing symptoms of Covid 19 should not enter the hall for any reason.**

We are thankful for the cooperation of our users and look forward to welcoming many of you back over the coming months.
